7-12th Grade Yearly Awards:

National Junior High Honor Society (NJHS): Students in grades 7-9 with a 3.0 GPA and Proficient or Advanced CST scores are invited to apply for membership. These applications are then reviewed by the Faculty Council for criteria qualifications of leadership, citizenship, character and service before inviting students as a candidate.

National Honor Society (NHS): Students in grades 10-12 with a 3.0 GPA and Proficient or Advanced CST scores in two test categories are invited to apply for membership. These applications are then reviewed by the Faculty Council for additional criteria qualifications, such as leadership, service, and character, before inviting the student as a candidate of the honor society.

President's Educational Achievement Program Award (PEAP): This academic recognition is given to the top 25% of the 8th and 12th grade classes.

Valedictorian/Salutatorian Candidates: Seniors must meet or surpass minimum qualifications to be considered and then recognized as Val/Sal. The Parent/Student Handbook lists criteria that encompass scholarship, student involvement and character. The principal makes the final decision based on recommendations by the Department Chairs.
