Educational Activity Grant

Purpose

The Lewis Center Foundation will consider requests from teachers and students for financial support towards opportunities to participate in educational activities that are likely to contribute significantly to their knowledge, experience and professional development. The activity should support the mission of the Lewis Center for Educational Research, which is "to ensure our schools and programs prepare students for success in a global society through data driven, innovative, and research proven practices in a safe and inclusive culture". (Not applicable for college tuition, books, etc.)

Amount

Grant awards are based on fund availability.

How Fund is Sustained

• Scholarship Fund – raised by Lewis Center Foundation

Guidelines/Criteria

- Awards are based on the total need of the teacher or student, the teacher or student's overall effort to raise the necessary funds, and on the educational merits of the program.
- Awards must be for activities that are outside of the approved Lewis Center for Educational Research budget.
- Applicants must be a Lewis Center staff member or student.

Application Form/Process

Applicants must complete the required application. They shall be available to answer any questions regarding the application.

Selection Process/Committee

Lewis Center Foundation Board members and Lewis Center staff select recipients.

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
