## **Student with Close Contact Exposure At**

## Home

Definition of Close Contact: Student has been within 6 feet of an individual at school (masked or unmasked) who has been diagnosed positive for COVID-19 for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more, over a 24-hour period.

\*Individuals are considered unvaccinated if they have not completed a primary series with any COVID-19 vaccine; OR are vaccinated and eligible for a booster, but have not yet received a booster. This does not include individuals previously infected with COVID-19 within the last 90 days.

If Student is able to isolate from the positive person:

Exposed student stays home for at least 5 days from the last exposure to the positive person.

Exposed student stays home for at least 5 days from the last exposure to the positive person.

- 1. If the test is negative for COVID-19 and the student is still asymptomatic, contact the school health office with the result and the student may return to school.
- 2. If the test is positive, the student must remain at home.
  Contact the health office with the result and follow
  Student Tests Positive for COVID Procedure chart.

If the exposed student is unable to or chooses not to test on or after day 5, the student remains home for the full 10 days. Exposed student stays home

If the positive person's COVID test is negative on or after day 5 of their isolation, the exposed student stays home 5 more days from the positive person's negative test.

The exposed student stays home 5 days after the positive person's negative test and may test on or after that 5th day:

If the positive person is unable to or chooses not to test on or after day 5 OR if they still test positive, the exposed student remains at home until the positive person's 10 day quarantine ends.

The exposed student stays home 5 more days after the positive person's 10 day quarantine ends and may test on or after that 5th day:

- 1. If the test is negative for COVID-19 and the student is still asymptomatic, contact the school health office with the result and the student may return to school.
- 2. If the test is positive, the student must remain at home.
  Contact the health office with the result and follow
  Student Tests Positive for COVID Procedure chart.

If student becomes symptomatic in any of the above scenarios, see Student with Symptoms of COVID-19.

\*Student may not participate in extracurricular activities, sports, clubs and after school activities throughout the duration of their quarantine

If the exposed student is unable to or chooses not to test on or after day 5, the student remains home for the 10 days after the positive person's test was negative.

If the exposed student is unable to or chooses not to test on or after day 5, after the positive person's isolation has ended, then the student remains home for an additional 10 days (20 days total).
