Student with Group Exposure At School

Definition of Group Exposure: Students who spent more than a cumulative total of 15 minutes (within a 24-hour time period) in a shared indoor airspace (e.g. classroom) with someone with COVID-19 during their period of infectiousness.

Student will be notified by school health office that they have been exposed to someone who is COVID-19 positive.

Exposed student should test 3 – 5 days after last exposure, regardless of vaccination status.

Exposed student who participates in testing, may continue to take part in all aspects of school, including sports and extracurricular activities, unless they develop symptoms or test positive.

If exposed student develops symptom, see Symptoms of COVID-19 Procedure Chart. Exposed students who receive a positive test result should immediately contact school health office and isolate at home in accordance with Student Tests Positive for COVID Procedure Chart.

FDA-approved rapid antigen (including at-home kits) or PCR COVID-19 test is accepted. Visit http://www.lewiscenter.org/COVID-19/ for additional testing information provided on-site by the school.
