- 6. Learn to articulate your capabilities: explain what you have to offer and why they should choose you out of all the applicants.
- 7. **Highlight your best qualities and passions**: Briefly highlight your extracurricular activities and achievements, and showcase your dedication, time management skills, and commitment to the organization.
- 8. **Be honest**: Be honest about yourself, especially if it's a flaw you want to work on. The ambassadors don't expect perfection; instead, they seek someone who is flexible and can easily learn and take criticism.
- 9. **Avoid cliches**: Do not say your weakness is being a perfectionist or anything along those lines. Instead, be honest about your flaws and end with how you're improving that quality of yourself.
- 10. **Share unique experiences**: Display your uniqueness through rare circumstances and difficulties that showcase your skills and talents.
- 11. **Ask relevant questions**: Prepare to ask a question that displays your interest in the program and showcases your desire to learn more.
- 12. **End with a "thank you"**: End the interview by thanking everyone for their time and giving you the opportunity to interview.
