.01 Apple Valley Center for Innovation (AVCI) Explainer Scholarship – Lisa Lamb informed the Foundation Board about AVCI, which is a partnership with LCER and AVUSD. It is located on our original campus and was established to benefit the entire community. Buildings are owned by the LCER and the property is owned by the District. We have a MOU to jointly provide programs, field trips and STEM nights. Student docents from AVHS, GHHS and AAE are the "Explainers". They would like to launch a scholarship open to the Explainers from the 3 high schools. It would be a minimum of \$500, per our scholarship policy. We could solicit donors to support the scholarship and use unrestricted scholarship funds to kick it off. When NSLA has seniors, we will need to double our scholarship opportunities. The Transition Coordinator is the point person for scholarship opportunities and promotes the scholarships. The LCER is a community based organization and benefits our communities at large. This helps us secure additional partnerships. Lisa will work with our staff and move forward on the scholarship. Teresa will send out scholarship information to the Foundation Board.

.02 Fundraisers – Jisela Corona

- i. High Desert Brew Fest Teresa and Jisela stopped by Off the Grid as a potential location for the brew fest and it looked a little small. We plan to contact Oak Hills Brewery instead. Jisela will call them today. Casey Armstrong is opening a bar at the Apple Valley Golf Course. She would be open to fundraisers once they open.
- ii. McDonald's Fundraiser Marisol brought this to the group. Jisela thought it would be good to do it during staff appreciation week in May. We would do one in each community. We would get 20% of all sales during the event. Coloring sheets could be distributed and the class with the most participation could get happy meal gift cards. We could get school admin, exec team, ambassadors, board members and Foundation to help. The funds would go to unrestricted. We will follow up with Marisol for dates and what we need to do.

iii. Annual Gala

- 2. Theme Jisela reviewed some names for the gala she came up with. Celestial Soirée was the theme selected.
