BP 3554: Other Food Sales

Adopted: September 12, 2011 Revised:

The Governing Board shall permit food sales by student or adult entities or organizations provided that these sales are in compliance with state and federal regulations so as to ensure optimum student participation in the school food service program. Such food sales shall not impair the food service's ability to be financially sound.

Sanitation and safety procedures shall comply with the requirements of the California Uniform Retail Food Facilities Law as set forth in Health and Safety.

Schools that participate in the National School Lunch Program and/or School Breakfast Program shall allow no foods of minimal nutritional value to be sold in food service areas during breakfast and lunch periods. At least 50% of all foods offered for sale at any school on any school day must be nutritious.

Use of Outside Food Vendors

Foods shall not be sold on organization school premises by outside commercial food vendors during school sessions. The profits from all food sales, including vending machines which sell approved food or drinks, must benefit either the school, the school food service program, or the student groups sponsoring the sales.
