Signed Statements

The Foundation Board requires all employees who are child care custodians, medical practitioners or non-medical practitioners, as defined by Penal Code <u>11165</u>, to report known or suspected instances of child abuse.

Prior to employment, persons in the above positions shall sign a statement to the effect that the employee knows of the legal requirement to report known or suspected instances of child abuse and is prepared to comply with this provision of law.

The CEO or designee shall ensure that the provisions of this policy are carried out in accordance with the law.
