BP 6177: INSTRUCTION SUMMER SCHOOL

Adopted: June 9, 2008 Revised:

The Foundation Board recognizes that summer school provides valuable opportunities for students to improve their skills and make academic progress when the need is demonstrated and funds are available. The CEO/President or designee, with board approval, shall establish summer school day and/or evening classes for purposes of remediation, enrichment and/or acceleration.

The LCER shall offer summer instructional programs for graduating high school seniors who need courses for graduation before the beginning of the next school year.

The LCER's summer school program may be used to provide supplemental instruction for student's failing to meet academic requirements.

Enrollment Priorities

Priority to enroll in summer programs shall be given to LCER students who:

- 1. Are eligible for supplemental instruction on the basis of retention or recommendation for retention.
- 2. Are eligible for supplemental instruction on the basis of insufficient progress toward passing the state high school exit examination.
- 3. Need course credits in order to graduate from high school before the beginning of the next school year.

The remaining openings shall be offered to LCER students on a first-come first-served basis.

Attendance

Because summer courses cover extensive instructional content in a relatively short time period, attendance is mandatory. One day missed may be cause for removal.
