Fundraising Activities

Guidelines/Criteria

- Applicants must be graduating seniors at the Academy for Academic Excellence
- Must plan on pursuing higher education
- Must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0
- Must have demonstrated involvement in community service (on or off campus)
- Financial need will be considered
- Awards must be used to pay for tuition, books, school related fees, and/or room and board
- Awards will be sent to accredited institution

Application Form/Process

- Applicants must complete the required application and include the following:
 - An Official Academic Transcript
 - Applicant Consent Form
 - Reference letter from a community organization, teacher or work supervisor
 - A 500 word essay (double spaced) that addresses the importance of one's involvement in community service
