How Fund is Sustained

Interest From Principle Endowment of \$10,000

Guidelines/Criteria

- Applicants must be graduating Seniors at AAE, AVHS or GHHS
- Applicants must have demonstrated interest in aeronautics and related fields (aviation classes, flying lessons or pilot license, Civil Air Patrol, etc.)
- Students must have taken either the SAT or ACT college aptitude test (waived for trade/vocational school applicants)
- Students must be pursuing further education in aeronautics or related subjects
- Financial need will be considered
- Awards must be used to pay for tuition, books, school related fees, and/or room and board (receipts and acceptance letter required)
- Awards will be sent to accredited institution

Application Form/Process

- Applicants must complete the required application and include the following:
 - > A brief written statement about interests, plans and goals
 - > A 300 word essay (double spaced) on describing future plans in aviation/aeronautics
 - > Application Consent Form
 - > An Official Academic Transcript
 - > SAT/ACT Scores
 - > Two letters of recommendation (one may be from a teacher, counselor or other school official; the second must be from someone in the community who is not a family member)

Selection Process/Committee

 Recipients are selected by the Scholarship committee and representatives from AVHS and GHHS
