

Student Exposed to COVID-19

Students are no longer required to quarantine if they are close contact exposures to an individual who is positive for COVID-19. This includes all students, regardless of vaccination status. [California Department of Public Health - Guidance on Isolation and Quarantine](#)

Student (with no symptoms) who is close contact exposure should test within 3-5 days after last exposure. If previously infected in the last 30 days, student does not need to test unless symptoms develop. [Rapid antigen tests are available for free in the school health office.](#)

Student should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings.

If symptoms develop or close contact tests positive for COVID-19, follow LCER's flowcharts - [Student Who Test Positive for COVID-19](#) or [Student With COVID-19 Symptoms](#).

***Students who are close contact exposures are not required to notify school nurse.**

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
