Student Exposed to COVID-19

Students are no longer required to quarantine if they are close contact exposures to an individual who is positive for COVID-19. This includes all students, regardless of vaccination status. <u>California Department of Public Health - Guidance on Isolation and Quarantine</u>

Student (with no symptoms) who is close contact exposure should test within 3-5 days after last exposure. If previously infected in the last 30 days, student does not need to test unless symptoms develop. Rapid antigen tests are available for free in the school health office.

Student should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings.

If symptoms develop or close contact tests positive for COVID-19, follow LCER's flowcharts – <u>Student Who Test Positive for COVID-19</u> or <u>Student With COVID-19 Symptoms</u>.

*Students who are close contact exposures <u>are not</u> required to notify school nurse.



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
